Did you know ACEC offers FirstCall Service?

FirstCall is our emergency response system that is activated by a fall or by pressing a button. The FirstCall client wears a water-resistant pendant either around the neck or on the wrist.

When the client presses the pendant, a trained emergency response operator, available 24/7, receives the signal. If emergency medical help is needed, the operator contacts the appropriate support. In a non-emergency, the operator will contact designated family, friends or neighbors.

FirstCall is available to ACEC members and non-members within our service territory.


